Action Strategies: How will we arrive at our vision?

1. Streamline and expand Home Health Hazards identification and education in existing programs
2. Expand housing rehabilitation programs to include rentals
3. Explore feasibility of a rental registry to improve data on rental properties
4. Align and coordinate lead remediation efforts
5. Continue and expand eviction mitigation efforts to improve housing stability

Potential Community-Level Indicators

Number of rental housing rehabs completed

Number of home health education sessions completed

(Reduction in) Percent of children tested with blood lead levels $> 3.5 \mu\text{g}/\text{dL}$

(Reduction in) Percent of housing with incomplete kitchen facilities or incomplete plumbing

Who Is Better Off?

Community-Level Outcome(s)

Residents have a diversity of housing opportunities and associated supportive services.

Children live in safe housing and healthy communities, free from environmental hazards.

Mixed-income **neighborhoods** are provided physical, economic, and social resources aimed at promoting healthy living.
